Enabling and Disabling Through Online Banking

Online Banking Quick Reference Guide

Account alerts and notifications act as an automated, real-time security guard for your money. By turning on these mobile text or email alerts, members receive instant updates the moment a low balance is reached, a large withdrawal occurs, or a new device logs into their profile. This immediate visibility allows members to halt unauthorized transactions instantly and pause spending before triggering expensive overdraft fees. Ultimately, these notifications turn passive account monitoring into active, hands-on financial defense.

Tips & Tricks

Review and update your alert preferences after first login.

Review scheduled payments before due dates.

Confirm payment history transferred correctly.

Monitor pending payments during transition week.

- Deposit Posted

How to set up alerts and notifications:

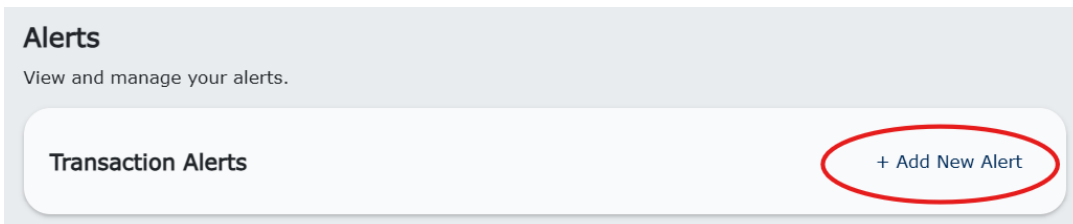
1. Click on the bell next to your profile icon.
